**SOME CONSIDERATIONS ABOUT THE CIVILIAN SETTLEMENTS
FROM THE PROXIMITY OF THE NORTH DANUBIAN LIMES
OF THE ROMAN PROVINCE MOESIA INFERIOR**

In this article we analyse those discoveries which prove the existence of civilian settlements in the immediate neighbourhood of the South Moldavian mud walls (linear fortifications having the role of *limes* for the Roman Province *Moesia Inferior*). The settling of the civilians near these military structures, within the Roman mud wall Trajan-Tulucești, must have been done with the agreement of the Roman Administration. The artefacts discovered within this area prove that only two establishments existed here, during the III-rd and the IV-th centuries. At its turn, this proves that even after their retreat from the Lower Danube, the Romans still exerted some control upon this area.
