

**DESCOPERIRILE FUNERARE SÂNTANA DE MUREȘ-CERNEAHOV  
DE LA LĂCENI-CIOROAICA (JUD. TELEORMAN)**

**THE SÂNTANA DE MUREȘ-CERNEAHOV  
FUNERAL DISCOVERIES FROM LĂCENI-CIOROAICA,  
TELEORMAN COUNTY**

This article focused on some data pertaining to the funeral discoveries from Lăceni village (Teleorman County), the place called “Cioroaica”.

Three tombs belong to the Sântana de Mureș-Cerneahov culture. They were investigated during the campaign carried out under SRAP project, in 2000. The inventory is common for this period: different types of clay vessels (legged pots, bowls, dishes, cups and pots), silver and bronze fibulas, a silver buckle, blue glass and *Spondylus* beads.

These recent discoveries add some new information to the data acquired from the investigations of the tombs found at Olteni and Lăceni. There are also a few settlements belonging to the same culture in this area, in Lăceni, Măgura and Vitănești. All these discoveries offer us an enriched image of Sântana de Mureș-Cerneahov culture in the South-West of Muntenia.
