

***GALAȚI – DUNĂREA DISTRICT. REPORT OF PREVENTIVE
ARCHAEOLOGICAL RESEARCH - 2011***

Keywords: Dunărea district, Galați, Roman necropolis, inhumation tomb, castellum

The preventive archaeological researches were carried out in the northern part of the protection area of Dunărea District archaeological site. Nineteen sections were traced in all, marked S I - S 19, of different lengths in relation to the property layout, 2 m wide and separated by 0.50 m marks, of NE - SW orientation.

Seven tombs, in a precarious state of conservation, and several dust holes were discovered, pertaining to the early Roman Era, as well as a dust hole from the Modern Era. One should notice the inventory of an inhumation tomb (M 6) consisting of a *Tetrassarion*-type coin, issued in Tyras during the time of Caracalla, a pendant made of glass beads, a golden *lunula* and a fragmentary oenochoe.

The chronologic and stratigraphic relation between the horizon of the dust holes and that of the necropolises will be clarified once the researches are extended.
